- Posters presentations will be judged. You must attend your poster during the specified judging time. Rehearse a short 3-5 minute description of your project and be prepared to stand at the poster fair. You will be judged on presentation, data clarity, originality, and your involvement in the project. Awards will be given to the best judged poster presenters from each institution.
- Frances Colón, PhD, Deputy Science and Technology Adviser to the Secretary of State, will be our Distinguished Speaker in the GCCRI Auditorium.
- Awards will be presented immediately following the presentation by the Distinguished Speaker.
